Tecate Mission is an IRS 501(c)(3) tax-exempt corporation, and all tax deductible contributions are acknowledged with an official tax deductible receipt. For this reason, the financial records of Tecate Mission are audited annually by an independent Certified Public Accounting firm in San Diego, Ca. A confirmation of this audit will be sent to you upon request.

## About us

Tecate Christian School is a ministry of Tecate Mission International.

Since its beginning in 1968 it has been located on the campus of our International Headquarters in Tecate, California, just 1500 feet from the international border of the United States and Mexico.

The staff seeks to maintain high academic standards based upon biblical principles. The majority of our students are Mexican citizens who reside in Mexico and cross the border daily to attend a complete immersion program as English Language Learners (ELL).

This small school on the border offers classes for grades 1 – 6.

## Our Doctrinal Position

**WE BELIEVE** in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost: they that are saved to the resurrection of life, and they that are lost to the resurrection of damnation.

**WE BELIEVE** in the obligation of the saved to obey our Lord's command to proclaim the Gospel to all mankind.
