Missionary Carl Olson shares the following, "A man told us today that our next service with him in prison will be his last because he is being released. He said that he has mixed feelings about getting out because he started his life with the Lord with us a few years ago and he looks to us as his spiritual parents. God has allowed us to build into his life. We gave him a list of churches in the city where he is going and he wrote to each of them. One church will be coming to visit him before he gets out to help him transition. God has put this all together! Praise Him!" Carl also shared their joy because of another prisoner coming to faith in Christ. Carl states," We praise God for that! We have spent several years crying with him, talking with him, praying with him...just loving on him, and he has now accepted Jesus as his Savior! May God be glorified!"



La Roca Coffee House is an extension of La Roca church led by missionaries Andy and Jessica Clark. The coffee house is a gathering place for meeting and witness. A large amount of people who come are young college students from the local university just a few blocks away. They offer a safe environment for families and teens. A Christian library and board games are offered for anyone to use.

On Sunday nights the coffee house is open with the goal of the church doing evangelism. Different members are being trained.
