Pondering Three Crosses and Ourselves


Reflections by TMI Executive Director Ron Hoffman

Two thousand years ago, three crosses stood on a hill outside of Jerusalem...it's the

"old, old story" that we know so well, but have you ever stopped and pondered which cross identifies you?



The center cross, the one that bore our Savior, so intentionally placed, has become the center of humanity's and history's attention. Wars have been fought and martyrs have died because of it. People have risked their lives and fortunes for its service. The calendar starts and ends





Then there is the cross to the side on which a thief died...so very close to our Savior, yet railing and unrepentant...he died in his sin to be eternally separated from his Creator.
