What happens during deputation?

The appointee represents the mission at various speaking opportunities, sharing the vision and ministry plans with churches, groups and interested individuals. As the Lord supplies finances, a monthly report is made to the Executive Director. After sufficient support has either been raised or promised, the appointee is ready to embark on a missionary career.

We encourage each appointee to be officially commissioned by their home church, because this relationship between the missionary and the sending church is vitally important.

When the new missionary begins service with TMI he or she begins a probationary period. ** After a satisfactory one-year review, the missionary then becomes a permanent member of Tecate Mission International.

What are the requirements to serve in this ministry?

- You must have an active personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
- You must be convinced that the Lord wants you to serve with this ministry.
- You should be committed enough to sacrifice convenience and comfort.
- You need the ability to adapt to new circumstances and work easily with other people.
- You should have specific skills to offer the missionary force.
- You must be willing to receive cross cultural training as it is necessary.
- You must be in good health.
- You will need to make a minimum commitment of two years.
- You will need to depend upon the Lord to supply financial needs as you work to raise your support team.

If I want to serve with TMI, what should I do next?

1. Make Contact

Use the information on this brochure to contact our headquarters either by phone, letter or e-mail. Please address this contact directly to our Executive Director. Let us know of your interest in joining our team .. An information package will be sent to you immediately. After prayerful consideration of this material, those interested in serving should request an application.

2. Apply

This next step is for the applicant to mail the completed application along with a recent photo. By signing the formal application, the applicant signifies agreement with the doctrinal statement and philosophy of TMI. Paperwork then begins in the Executive Office of TMI. References are sent to each name indicated on the application.

The reference responses and the application papers comprise the applicant's personnel file. The applicant must then meet for a personal interview. If this interview is satisfactory, the Executive Director will then make recommendations to the Executive Board to interview the applicant and to make its final decision.

3. Becoming a Candidate

If the board deems the application and references are satisfactory, the applicant will be invited before them for an interview.

4. Become an Appointee

Upon board approval, the candidate becomes an appointee. An appointee usually spends some time on deputation (to raise a support team for prayer, finances and accountability) before starting his or her missionary career.
