God Continues to Move in Hearts Throughout TMI

Join me as I take you on a brief journey to some of the ministry locations

First, we will get a brief resume of Director Ron
Hoffman's recent trip to Chiapas and Oaxaca. He
visited missionaries David & Lorena de Jesus
Aguilar who serve in Comalapa & Chemic
Roberto & Fidalina Gonzales in Mexecalapa & 20
de Noviembre, and Antonio & Hubeydi López in
Brasil. He gave counsel and encouragement as he
listened to stories of disappointment and victory.
He participated in visitation, church services, and
personal evangelism. He also conducted two
interviews with possible candidates for TMI.

Ron spent an exciting time in San Mateo del Mar, Oaxaca, with Pastor Esteban & Isabel Hinojosa. We welcome Isabel into the membership of TMI. She is a dedi-



cated Christian who lovingly helps to meet the spiritual and medical needs of the Huave people.

RADIO: Some of you have helped to purchase the new equipment to expand the radio potential. The Gospel is being shared. Stay turned.

Ron saw the beginnings of a **CHRISTIAN SCHOOL** which soon will be completing the necessary requirements of the Mexican educational system. TMI wants to eventually help build separate classrooms and bathrooms. (NOTE: A fund has been started for permanent facilities for this school.)

Ron stated, "I am a blessed man to be with and to learn from these dedicated missionaries."

Now.....

I want you to be encouraged on this journey how God uses TMI missionaries in the great southern state of OAXACA. Even though there is religious opposition, traditions and superstition which cause obstacles in presenting the Gospel, the Lord is still the One who works in hearts.

Let's start 4 hours south of Oaxaca City where **we observe** the training and teaching of missionary

Our journey now takes us away from the city traveling on a long trip up a winding mountain road to visit missionaries Isaias & Rebeca López, Abdon & Rafaela



López, and Chuy & Albina Valenzuela. While we are there, enjoy the beautiful scenery and lush green growth all around. We may walk for hours to some of the areas where the precious Word is taught and studied. Your hearts will be encouraged to witness God's hand at work among the Mixteco ethnic group.

Our TMI missionary journey continues.....

Please do not get weary as we now go to the state of Jalisco and visit Antonio & Silvia Diaz at Estrella de Belen church and the migrant camps, then on to the Conference Center where Andy & Jessica Clark work and minister. They will invite us to their new church/coffeehouse location which brings a renewed fervor to their ministry.

I hope you are well rested because we are going into a rugged territory of La Cumbre, Chihuahua, in northern Mexico to visit missionary Jesus Rivera and Raramuri converts, Alberto & Lupe. Make sure you have good hiking boots. The terrain will require fortitude on this trek into remote, dangerous areas.



We will now fly to Tanzania to be with missionaries Victor and Daniela Estrada. Leaving them we will quietly visit another dedicated TMI couple

who are working in a creative access area. We want to encourage them all yet not be a cause of danger.

There are still more to visit on our journey. Let us go visit veteran missionaries, Ricardo and Ruth Salvador in Texas and learn from their years of experience. Then on we go to Carl and Kathy Olson in Wisconsin. The Olsons have dedicated their lives to prison ministry where they have seen many prisoners find hope and peace in Jesus.

You will be blessed as **we continue on up to Washington** to visit **Jerry and Candis Bingham**.

They too are veteran missionaries continuing to pour their lives into others.

We return now to ministries in Mexico near the California U.S.A. border. Let us go to Ensenada and visit three TMI churches located there under the leadership of Ever & Lupe Pérez and Ernesto & Francisca Gámez. Yes,

Let us go up the hill to the campus of the Bible Institute of TMI.

Associate Carlos and Barbara
Escobar will be there to guide you

around the facilities, to introduce you to students, and to share news with you concerning the ministry locations of alumni and also the vision for the future. As well as Alex & Guille Goribar will share their desire to soon relocate in Michoacán(la ventana de silencio), where there is a great need for the Gospel. Elda Martínez and her husband have hearts for children and are given to reaching them for Christ. As you go back down the hill, you will conclude that much is happening for God's glory through this ministry which has many tentacles spread out around the world.

We are back at headquarters!

I want you to be encouraged by what you see and hear happening within these walls! You are now located



1500 feet from the Mexican American border.

Let us stop at the Distribution Center where food, household goods, and clothing are given out. Then

we go to the Bible
Correspondence offices
and talk to Barbara
Barrones. Lessons are
received and corrected
for 100's of students in
different countries and
walks of life.

"... thank you for the Bible courses. I have been incarcerated for the last 16 years and I guess everyone that used to send me mail just faded away. I thank God that He has chosen to use you all to comfort one of His sheep in prison."

Christian School. You will see enthusiasm as the teachers and students apply themselves stu-

diously to their academic learning. *I want you to meet the dedicated teaching staff with principal Ron Hoffman*. *Grades 1 - 9* are taught academics saturated with Biblical teaching. The teachers are Melanie-Joy Rodriguez, Daniel & Mary Kapitaniuk, Esther Bowman, Toni Jackson, Rebecca Heib, and Bill DeBerg. The staff uses opportunities to share

spiritual truths with the families as well.

Please pray and help us spread the need for a principal, teachers, and workers at TCS for the coming year. Our sympathies go to the family of John Jenstad. He went to be with the Lord, and he will be greatly missed

by all TMI co-laborers, students, and friends.
